



## VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES with LITERACY CONNECTIONS

- **TUTORING: 1-1 with an adult, or small group instruction for adults:** Priority One is always TUTORING. That is what we are here for. We provide Tutor Training Workshops in the Spring and Fall, but if a group of 6 or more get together, we will provide specially scheduled training in between these times. Tutors can choose to work with English or non-English speakers, in small group or 1-1.
